STM and LTM are separate memory structures.	Things that affect STM do not affect LTM and vice versa.	Rundus (1971)
STM is a unitary store.	People can have deficits that affect STM for some forms of information but not others.	Warrington & Shallice (1972)
LTM is a unitary store.	People can have deficits that affect LTM for some forms of information but not others.	Milner et al (1968)
Rehearsal is necessary to maintain information in STM.	When people are prevented from rehearsing information they forget it very quickly.	Glanzer & Cunitz (1966)
Rehearsal is necessary to transfer information to LTM.	People can form long term memories of information without rehearsing it.	Craik & Tulving (1975)
